Viongozi wapinga mpango wa kutoza ada Dongo Kundu

Barabara hiyo ambayo inaendelea kukamilishwa inatarajiwa kupiga jeki Kaunti ya Kwale kiuchumi

SIRU chache tu baada ya barabara kuu ya Dongo Kundu kufunguliwa upande mmoja, viongozi wa Kwale wameonyesha kutocidhishwa na hatua ya Mamlaka ya Barabara Kuu ya Kenya (KeNHA) ya kutoza ada watumiaji wa barabara hiyo.

Viongozi hao walisisema kulipisha madaraka kunaenda kinyume na lengo kuu la barabara hiyo ambalo lilikuwa ni kuboresha uchumi wa kaunti hiyo na kuvutia wawekezaji eneo hilo.

Katika taarifa ya hivi majuzi, KeNHA iliondhesha barabara kuu ya Dongo Kundu muongozi mwa barabara nyingine nchini zikakazowekewa vituu vya kutoza ada kwa watumiaji.

Wakiongozwa na Seneta Maalum wa Kwale, Bw Raphael Chimera, viongozi hao wal-

isisema kuwa hawatakuhali wananchi kulipia kutumia barabara hiyo, kwani haitakawa haki kwao.

Akizungumza akiwa Kwale wakati wa ligi ya Chimera Cup, alisema kuwa anashukuru kwamba barabara hiyo imefunguliwa lakini serikali inapaswa kutafuta itumie bila malipo ili itamize madhumuni yake.

"Ninaashukuru serikali kwa kufungua barabara hii, lakini tunataka iwe bure na hakuna mikazi hata mmoja anayepaswa kulipa hata senti ili kurubuswa kutumia," alisema Bw Chimera.

Kwa upande wake, Mbunge wa Matuga, Bw Kassim Tandara, alisema itakuwa si haki kwa wakazi wa Kwale kutoza ada kwa kutumia barabara hiyo mpya ilhali barabara nyingine kati katika sehemu mbalimbali za nchi zimetumiwa bila malipo kwa miaka mingi.

Alisema barabara hiyo ni muhimu kwa kufungua nafasi za ajira na kuvutia wawekezaji katika kaunti hiyo.

"Wanapaswa kuanza kwa kutoza zile ambazo zilijengwa miaka mingi iliyopita," alisema Bw Tandara.

Kwa upande wake, Mbunge wa Msambweni, Bw Faisal Bader,

alisema barabara hiyo ni daraja pekee la kuunganisha Kwale na maji mingine.

"Tukianza kutoza ada, tutawafukuza wawekezaji wanachitaji mazingira bora ya kufanya biashara," alisema Bw Bader.

Gavana wa Kwale, Bi Fatuma Achari, alisema kuwa barabara hiyo alijengwa ili kuendeleza Kaunti ya Kwale na kumaikazi tayan wanakabiliwa na changamoto za kiuchumi na kulipia barabara hiyo itakuwa mzigo mkubwa.

Barabara hiyo iko katika hatua zake za mwisho za ujenzi na ni sehemu moja tu imefunguliwa kutumiwa na wazendeshaji magari madogo.

Barabara hiyo ilipofunguliwa, wadau wa utalii walisisfika hatua hiyo wakisema itapandisha adadi ya wapenzi huko Diani.

Hata hivyo, baadhi ya wananchi waliohojiwa na Taifa Leo walisisema hata wakilipishwa kutumia barabara hiyo itakuwa sawa maanake tayan wazendeshaji magari bulipishwa kutumia feri za Likoni.

Katika kivucho cha feri Likoni, magari bulipishwa kati ya Sh120 na Sh7,900 kwa kutegemea ulubwa na aina ya mzingo unaoafishwa.

Chapter 7 of the Constitution examines public participation in public finance management in Kenya as enshrined in the Constitution of Kenya 2010. Specifically, the chapter examines the following:

- (i) The constitutional and legislative public participation opportunities in Kenya
- (ii) The mechanisms through which the public can effectively participate in financial matters.
- (iii) Recommendations for effective public participation in fiscal decision-making processes.

The Constitution and the PFM Act, 2012 provide a distinct opportunity to enhance the role of citizens in public financial management processes in Kenya. Chapter Twelve of the Constitution deals with Public Finance. Article 201 introduces principles of public finance, among them being, openness and accountability including public participation in financial matters. These principles, if strictly adhered to, would strengthen policy formulation and management of public resources for the improved livelihoods of many Kenyans. Similarly, public participation in planning, budgeting and oversight at both the national and County levels of Government is guaranteed by the Constitution of Kenya 2010 and the PFM Act, 2012. Sections 35(1) and 125 of the PFM Act, 2012 elaborately outline the stages in the budget process at the national and County Government levels respectively in any financial year. Despite these avenues, citizens may not effectively participate in fiscal decision making due to a number of reasons. Here, the following two reasons will suffice. The Constitution of Kenya 2010 introduces changes in the public finance management framework in Kenya. Specifically, Chapter Twelve of the Constitution, at Article 201 sets out the principles of public finance as follows:

- (a) Openness and accountability including public participation in financial matters;
- (b) Public finance system shall promote an equitable society;
- (c) Burdens and benefits of the use of resources and public borrowing shall be shared equitably between present and future generations;
- (d) Public money shall be used in prudent and responsible way; and
- (e) Financial management shall be responsible, and fiscal reporting shall be clear.

Tharaka Nithi County has been conducting public hearing forums during the development of County plans and during preparations of expenditure framework which always has been conducted by budget and economic planning team. During the public hearing forum, deliberations and contributions by members of the public were captured and reports prepared by the teams. The key highlights and project proposals were captured in the following sections.

During the public hearing forum, deliberations and contributions by members of the public were captured and reports prepared by the teams. In all the forums, the members of the public were taken through the budget cycle and specifically on the importance of the Annual Development Plan. They were also taken through the review of the previous ADPs (2023/24 and 2024/25 ADPS) as per chapter two of the draft 2025/26 ADP. During the presentations, it was evident that most of the projects planned for were not financed in the budget for FY 2024/25 due to scarce resources. During the plenary period, the public was informed that the priority for the county government is completion of all ongoing projects unless situation where new projects are justified to be implemented. The members of the public proposed the following projects:
